Background:

Gender-based violence against women and girls is widespread and harmful. It affects society as a whole and should be recognised as a global human rights issue. The fight against gender-based violence has been led for decades by women and women's rights movements. However, as underlined in the Council of Europe Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence ("[Istanbul Convention](#)"), men and boys also have an important role to play. They should be more aware that they are part of the solution – as well as being part of the problem. Men and boys have a responsibility to act to prevent and combat gender-based violence against women and girls.

The Round Table will aim to raise visibility of the Council of Europe and the Parliamentary Assembly work and standards on the role of men and boys to end violence against women and girls, facilitate discussions and networking with stakeholders and define take-away actions to make progress in this regard.
