

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies to adopt
the Opinion on the
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the
European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions**

EU Strategy on the rights of the child

COM(2021) 142

The Chamber of Deputies supports the EU Strategy on the rights of the child; protecting, promoting and transposing in practice of the rights of the child are among the fundamental objectives of the EU.

In the same time, the Chamber draws attention over the necessity to establish a balance between the activities from the digital environment and those implying direct work with children, as well as over the necessity to establish a consultation mechanism at EU level on participation of children to different types of cultural, educational and sports activities.

The Chamber of Deputies recommends: establishing a harmonised regulatory framework for creating independent enterprises for young people with disabilities, as well as a roadmap for the coordinated application of programmes regarding rights of the children from the rural areas or children with special needs.
