## **Opinion**

of 3 November 2022

**COM(2021) 209 final** Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of  
the Council laying down rules to prevent and combat child sexual abuse

The Austrian Federal Government, in particular the competent Federal Minister of the  
Interior, the Federal Minister of Justice and the Federal Minister for Women, Family,  
Integration and Media are requested to continue to work at the European level

- to further the development and increased EU-wide harmonisation and coordination  
of appropriate, effective and fundamental rights compliant measures to protect  
against child abuse and grooming online and offline, and

- in the context of the negotiations for a Regulation laying down rules on preventing  
and combating the sexual abuse of children (COM(2022) 209 final), to actively  
advocate for ensuring that this Regulation complies with fundamental rights and to  
only approve the said Regulation, if it is ensured that it complies with fundamental  
rights - in the sense of the continuous text.
