**RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE**

Delivered on the 27<sup>th</sup> Session held on the 14<sup>th</sup> of October 2020

**on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions EU Biodiversity Strategy for 2030 Bringing nature back into our lives (Senate Print No. K 061/12, COM(2020) 380)**

**The Senate**

**I.**

**1. Notes with concern**

that the current substantial decline in biodiversity has not been slowed down despite the long-standing European effort and therefore supports the EU Biodiversity Strategy for 2030;

**2. Recommends**

- a) to clearly define that the targets proposed in the EU Biodiversity Strategy for 2030 relate to the EU as a whole and to take into account different conditions of the individual Member States and their previous endeavour relevant for meeting these targets;
- b) that the Commission prepares and submits specific impact assessment studies of proposed targets not only at EU level but also at the level of the individual Member States which will also include the zero scenario (do nothing scenario);

**3. Requests the Government**

to establish appropriate instruments which will tangibly contribute to halting the loss of biodiversity in the Czech Republic when setting the national rules for the implementation of the new Common Agricultural Policy (CAP);

## **II.**

### **1. Requests**

the Government to inform the Senate by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021 about the way Article I.3 of this resolution was taken into account;

### **2. Authorises**

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
