

**Opinion No. 7**  
**of the European Union Affairs Committee**  
**of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland**  
**on**  
**“Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council**  
**amending Directive 96/71/EC of The European Parliament and of the Council of 16**  
**December 1996 concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of**  
**Services (COM(2016) 128 final)”**  
**adopted at the 40th meeting held on 30 March 2016.**

The European Union Affairs Committee of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland:

1. does not approve the “Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 96/71/EC of The European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 1996 concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of Services (COM(2016) 128 final)”;
2. welcomes the position of the government of the Republic of Poland presented in the instant case;
3. finds the “Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 96/71/EC of The European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 1996 concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of Services (COM(2016) 128 final)” incompatible with the principle of subsidiarity.
