Last week, ahead of the governmental NATO Summit, I met with you and other Presidents of Parliaments of NATO Member States to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the Parliamentary Assembly of the NATO.

The Parliamentary Assembly has been for the past 70 years a bridge to society, to critical voices, and to democratic checks and balances.

'Our founding fathers came together with one firm conviction: NATO's commitment to collective defence needs to be anchored firmly in the Alliance's democratic foundations, and this requires the active engagement of allied citizens through their elected representatives.'

It is therefore important that the leadership of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly is present during the The Hague Summit.

And speaking of anchoring defence in democratic foundations:

A week ago, ahead of the NATO Summit, the Dutch Senate debated on NATO. After a thorough debate in which the proponents and opponents exchanged their arguments in a measured manner, the Senate voted in favour of enshrining in law the 2% of GDP as the absolute lower limit.

I look forward to hearing from you what the experiences are from other parliaments.
